



FORCED MIGRATION AND INCLUSIVE HIGHER EDUCATION FOR REFUGEES

We are excited to announce that DIME is partnering with Opening Universities for Refugees to launch a unique certificate in Forced Migration and Inclusive Higher Education for Refugees for universities, NGOs, and civil society organizations in Mexico in 2024-2025.

This pilot Certificate program covers essential topics such as the history, current practices, and future projections of global forced migration, policies of refugee resettlement in Mexico, how to creatively leverage local resources to support refugee resettlement via complementary pathways, and best ethical practices in engaging refugee integration.

For the first time, two Mexican universities will receive this Certification in March 2024 in a hybrid version. OUR authorities will connect via Zoom, and DIME's team will attend in person. Participants will be able to attend in person at the University facilities. The dates are as follows:

- March 4-5 for the faculty, staff, students, and relevant actors of Universidad de Monterrey.
- March 6-7 for the faculty, staff, students, and relevant actors of Universidad La Salle Saltillo.

The schedule for each day is from 9 am-13:00 hrs, including coffee breaks.







Modules of the program are designed and will be delivered by experts and practitioners from the field of forced migration and inclusive higher education. All the modules will be delivered in English.

- Module 1: Global Forced Migration
- Module 2: Complementary education pathways in Mexico
- Module 3: Role of universities and civil society organizations- Ethics in working with displaced communities- broader community engagement
- Module 4: Group work around case studies Setting up action plans

Participants of the program will receive a DIME-OUR certificate, a graduation package with resources, and a follow-up one-to-one meeting opportunity with OUR team for an action plan building/further support. 1
